Webinar Opportunities for scientific collaboration within SURE

On 30 March 2023 SURE CE Chapter organized Webinar "Opportunities for scientific collaboration within SURE" in which 19 participants from 6 counties attended.



During the webinar representatives of the Polish National Agency of Academic Exchange presented funding opportunities available to scientists interested to come to Poland together with programs for those who are interested in hosting polish scientists.
