


SURE 2021 in Numbers

In 2021 SURE counts 398 active members (4 honorary members, 148 student members, 238 regular members, 3 unemployed members and 5 institutional members including 59 individual members). The international representation of urban ecology is reflected by the broad geographical background from the SURE members coming from Asia (237), Europe (125), North America (15), Latin America (13) and Africa (7) and Australia/Oceania (1).

SURE Activities in 2021

The 3rd SURE World Conference was a great success

Between 7 and 9 July 2021, the <u>3rd SURE World Conference</u> under the topic "Cities as Socio-Ecological Systems" took place in Poznan, Poland. Organized as a hybrid event due to the current pandemic restrictions, over 300 participants from 36 countries and 6 continents participated online and onsite at the conference.

In the participants' opinion, the SURE had three very rewarding days, filled with interesting plenary keynotes and sessions covering a high diversity of topics, including:



- Ecosystem services of all ecosystem types data, indicators, bundles, synergies and trade-offs
- Biodiversity in urban areas
- Social awareness of urban ecosystems
- Ecology of degraded areas
- Life quality in cities
- Green infrastructure in the urban areas

SURE president Prof. Dr. Jürgen Breuste and representatives from the SURE Chapter Central Europe (Dr. Luis Inostroza) and the SURE Chapter South East Europe (Prof. Dr. Cristian Ioja, head of session) participated with presentations and in the panel discussion. SURE contributed to the success of the event.

The International Environmental Fair (FIMA by its acronym in Spanish) becomes a benchmark opportunity in Latin America, which promotes sustainability and environmental care actions in today's society, strengthening synergies between professionals, buyers and exhibitors to showcase environmental products and services aimed at the productive sector, becoming the ideal meeting point for the different actors in the chain.

Among the organizers of this 7th version were the Ministry of Environment and Sustainable Development, Corferias and the Environmental Entrepreneurial Corporation – CAEM, a subsidiary of the Bogota Chamber of Commerce, to meet the environmental needs of the region and entrepreneur's.

More than 200 experts on environmental issues, 152 academic activities, 4,000 m² of exhibition space and 8,900 visitors made these four days of the fair an ideal event to continue promoting the care of the planet and the protection of natural resources. News from the SURE South-East-Europe Chapter


- The SURE South-East-Europe Chapter organized a <u>Symposium for National Geographers</u>
 <u>Students</u> Bucharest (27-28 March, 2021) and the <u>Symposium Constantin Bratescu Constanta</u>
 (September 17 -19, 2021). During the symposium in September an award for the best presentation in urban ecology was given to students.
- The chapter hosted Martina Marei Vitti, University of Bologna as a SURE internship at the University of Bucharest (September 9th November 9th, 2021).

SURE China Chapter participated at the 20th Annual Conference of the Ecological Society of China

The SURE China chapter actively participated at the 20th annual conference of the Ecological Society of China (ESC), Oct. 24-27, 2021, Shanghai, China. In the course of the conference, Junxiang Li and Weiqi Zhou, who are both EC members of the SURE China chapter, co-chaired a session named "Nature-based Solutions to Ecological Security in Urban Areas". The session consisted of nine oral



presentations covering diverse topics on lower carbon community, urban heat island and heat stress, food-energy-water nexus-based urban green infrastructure and urban resilience, urban ecosystem services optimization and sustainability, urban ecological risks assessment, and nature-based solutions to urban thermal stress and security. More than 150 participants, including nearly 50 on-site and more than 100 online, joined the sessions.





SURE participated at "The Nature of Cities Festival"

The Nature of Cities Festival was organized as an online event and took place from 22-26 February 2021. The festival offered a range of interesting inter- and transdisciplinary plenary talks, seed sessions and digital excursions.

• Revitalizing urban rivers (Spanish & English) (Ana Faggi (SURE Latin America Chapter), Juergen Breuste (SURE President), Circe Monteiro, Diana Wiesner, Iturriaga Sandra): The session included short presentations of revitalization projects (Bogota-Colombia, Mapocho-

Chile, Piracicaba- Brasil and Isar Germany) with a following discussion addressing SWOT analysis, what have we learned and the role of the community participation.

Soul in the city – connecting our inner and external nature (Martina Artmann (SURE Secretary General), Katharina Artmann): The session explored through a short presentation, meditation and interactive breakout rooms how to overcome the human/nature dichotomy. Afterwards a discussion followed on what it means to be a human being in cities and how we can experience urban nature as a sentient, soulful member of our kin. Statement of the SURE President on the <u>UN Biodiversity Conference (CBD COP 15)</u> in October 2021 in Kunming (China)

The UN Biodiversity Conference (CBD COP 15) in October 2021 in Kunming (China) stated despite on-going efforts, biodiversity is deteriorating worldwide and this decline is projected to worsen with business-as- usual scenarios. A new set of goals for nature over the next decade through the Convention on Biological Diversity post 2020 framework process will be necessary. This needs ambitious plans to implement broad-based actions to bring about a transformation in society's relationship with biodiversity and to ensure that, by 2050, the shared vision of living in harmony with nature. This is urgently necessary in the humans living sphere – the cities. We need a New Deal for nature in cities – urban biodiversity.

Special Issue linked with the SURE working group on urban agriculture published in Sustainability

"A Systemic Perspective on Urban Food Supply: Assessing Different Types of Urban Agriculture" edited by Martina Artmann (SURE Secretary General), Kathrin Specht, Jan Vávra and Marius Rommel.

This Special Issue was initiated in the course of various sessions organized by the guest editors in the course of the ESP Europe conference 2018 in San Sebastian (Spain), the IALE World Congress 2019 in Milan (Italy) and the Dresden Nexus Conference 2020 (Germany).

In total, the Special Issue comprises 15 articles including one conceptual paper and 14 case studies from different countries: Australia, Benin, China, Czechia, France, Germany, Italy, Mexico, New Zealand, Sweden, the Netherlands, and the UK. The papers cover a broad range of impact and



implementation dimensions, assessment methods and geographical backgrounds that can support future studies to develop a systemic perspective on urban food production.

"Smart City Development and Remote Sensing Application in Urban Ecology" edited by Tao Lin (SURE China), Peter van Bodegom and Pfaender Fabien,

This Special Issue was initiated in the course of smart city session organized by the guest editors in the course of the 3rd SURE World Conference (2021) and SURE China conference (2020).

In total, the Special Issue comprises ten articles including one conceptual paper and nine case studies from different countries: China, Denmark, Germany, Sweden, Australia, and the UK. The papers cover a broad range of urban ecology and remote sensing application including innovative and multidisciplinary researchers on the latest developments in urban data science, smart city application, remote sensing methods, and pilot urban ecosystem studies in the world, exploring the potential cooperation between the ecological city and the smart city.

The guest editors want to express our sincere thanks to all authors and reviewers who have contributed their time and effort to make this Special Issue success and we are looking forward to further exchange and research on this topic.
